Her journey in the entertainment industry started as a contestant in the duet-singing reality show Zing! aired on kykNET in 2003, after which, for about three years, she was part of the acapella group Cutt Glas. Over the years she has also been a member of groups like NX, The Dahlings and The Dinamiese Dames where she performed as a vocalist.

Nadia has portrayed many roles on stage, TV and the big screen and even had the opportunity to co-host Die Groot Ontbyt, while working as a radio presenter for GrootFM and kykNET. A definite highlight in her career up to now has been her work as anchor presenter for Boer Soek 'n Vrou, a popular reality show aired on kykNET.
